Guidelines

- Approximately 20-25 acres mowable
- Zero-turn or “lawn tractors” of any width are acceptable. Although anything wider than 72” will not be able to make it to the back side of the camp over the bridge, zero-turn mowers are more desired because they are easier to maneuver in some areas. The camp owns 3-60” zero-turn country clipper mowers that are controlled with a single joystick. They can be used if someone is familiar with those controls and is comfortable enough using that type of machine. Let me know in advance so I can have them fueled and ready to go.
- The more mowers, the easier the task. But a typical mowing crew usually has at least 4 mowers and 1 or 2 grass weed eaters
- Depending on the season of mowing, crews usually arrive between 8 and 9 am. If there’s any question about whether it’s too wet, stormy, etc., you can call Jeremy Souders at 765-571-2811 for the latest conditions. Please call if you are wondering whether the grass is too short to mow due to a lack of rain.
- Lunch and water are typically not provided on most mowing dates unless a special event is happening at camp. So bringing your own lunch/water is recommended. Some crews meet for breakfast at a local restaurant, then come out to mow. Bathrooms are available and open at the dining hall.
- The camp is divided by Ben Davis Creek. There is a bridge connecting the 2 sections. It is only big enough to support a mower with a 72” deck or less.
- We ask that all mowers set mowing depth to 3” and coordinate with each other to make sure mowers that might be mowing in the same area will be cutting approximately the same height.
- There is a section of grass across from the main entrance that does not belong to the camp, but we ask that groups mow it to keep the front area looking nice. It is on the north side of the road. It belongs to a local farmer, and it also helps him, so he doesn’t have to bring in his equipment.
