Position Summary:

The Summer Camp Lifeguard & Facilities Assistant ensures the safety and well-being of campers and staff during all aquatic activities while maintaining clean and welcoming facilities. This position also supports camp operations through dining hall assistance, concessions, and end-of-day cleanup responsibilities. The ideal candidate is dependable, safety-focused, and enthusiastic about contributing to a positive camp experience.

Key Responsibilities:

Waterfront & Aquatic Safety

- Supervise swimming and boating activities at the pool, lake, and waterfront areas.
- Enforce safety rules and respond effectively to emergencies.
- Conduct regular checks of the waterfront and pool equipment.
- Provide lifeguard coverage for night swimming events.
- Lock and secure the fish shack, lake, and waterfront areas at the end of each shift.

Cleaning & Maintenance

- Clean and maintain the pool house, bathrooms, and surrounding waterfront areas daily. Participate in lake and waterfront cleanups to help maintain a safe and attractive environment.
- Report any maintenance or safety concerns promptly to supervisors.

Dining & Concessions

- Assist with meal service and dining hall duties during supper, including setup, serving, and cleanup.
- Operate and restock concessions stands, ensuring friendly service and accurate transactions.

Teamwork & Camp Spirit

- Attend staff meetings, training sessions, and special events as needed.
 - Model positive behavior and teamwork, supporting campers and fellow staff.
Contribute to a safe, inclusive, and fun camp atmosphere.
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Qualifications:

- Must hold (or be willing to obtain before camp season):
 - Lifeguard Certification (American Red Cross or equivalent)
 - CPR/First Aid Certification
 - Must be at least 16 years old (18+ preferred).
Strong swimming skills and attention to safety are required.
 - Ability to lift to 50 lbs. and work outdoors in varying weather conditions.
 - Previous experience in aquatics, camps, or food service is a plus.
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Training & Uniforms:

All required training, certifications, and uniforms are provided at no cost by the camp.

- Committed Christian and active follower of Jesus
 - Aligns with the mission and values of the church and camp ministry
 - Heart for worship, discipleship, and serving others behind the scenes
 - Willing to participate in camp community life, devotions, and spiritual leadership
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Work Schedule:

- Shifts: 12:00 PM – 8:00 PM or 1:00 PM – 9:00 PM
- Occasional Saturdays and evenings are required for night swimming.
- Full-time, seasonal (typically late May – Late July)
